



## FROM THE ANDES TO THE JUNGLE

**Level: Intermediate+**

**Altitudes: between 12.900 and 2.100 ft**

**Season: June to September**

The Mantaro Valley was the main place from where the evangelization campaigns started during XVII century, most of them ending in a complete disaster thanks to braveness of Amazonian tribes. This trail will surprise you with its ecological diversity; departing from Lima in the coast we will pass the Andes Mountain Range to get in 2 mountain range stages into the Central Andes Valley of Mantaro River to start our main adventure: the pass to the Jungle starting at 13500ft arriving to the heath of the green rainforest at 2100ft.

### Itinerary

- 1 **LIMA/TARMA** Departure from Lima at 10h00. After crossing the Mountain range close to 15.000 ft we get the Tarma high lands starting a downhill ride to Tarma (9.150 ft) by the Inca trail and the road, arriving in the afternoon. Lodging.
- 2 **TARMA/ROYAL INCA TRAIL/JAUJA** Departure to Huaricolca pass (12.300 ft) by road, to take then a detour that takes us to the main Inca Trail that gets us to Paca Lagoon and Jauja village. Lodging.
- 3 **JAUJA/RICRAN/MONOBAMBA/SAN RAMON** Transfer to Tambillo pass for the beginning of the ride by a dirt road that was formerly a trail that Spanish Missionaries used for trying to conquest the native souls and their lands. We will begin from 13.500 ft downhill the Mountain Range by dirt road to San Ramon Village (1.800 ft). Lodging.
- 4 **SAN RAMON** Ride by San Ramon forest. Return to village in the afternoon. Lodging.
- 4 **SAN RAMON/LIMA** At 10h00 departure to Lima, arriving at 19h00.

**Included:** Transfers from/to Lima, guiding in English. Picnic and snacks during the rides. Lodging in Tarma, Jauja and San Ramón in double/triple bedroom + breakfasts. **Hardtail bike hire and helmet.**
